

# PREVENT BUSINESS ROBBERY



## **FOLLOW THESE ROBBERY PREVENTION TIPS FROM McGRUFF:**

- ✓ **Control your flow of cash. Install a drop safe for large bills, post limited cash signs, use secured services to make bank deposits, and never count money when the store is open.**
- ✓ **Keep your back door and storerooms locked at all times, and install an alarm or video monitoring security system.**
- ✓ **To deter criminals, keep your business clean and orderly and use bright lights at the entrance, in the store, and in parking lots.**
- ✓ **Increase visibility in your business with lower shelves, mirrors to monitor all entrances, and limited external signs.**
- ✓ **Use fences and landscaping to limit quick access to and from your business.**
- ✓ **You are part of the community in which your business is located. Offer incentives to attract desired clientele especially when open in late evening and early morning hours.**
- ✓ **Train your employees on how to behave during a robbery and other such safety measures as greeting all customers and establishing eye contact.**
