Detention Center resident seriously injured

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – About 12:45 p.m. Wednesday, May 18, 2022, a resident at the Al Cannon Detention Center jumped from the second-tier balcony level of a housing unit and landed on the first floor. Detention deputies and medical staff tended to the resident until EMS arrived. She was transported to MUSC with life-threatening injuries. The State Law Enforcement Division was asked to investigate.

UPDATE May 20, 2022

While Detention Center resident Patricia Sizemore was being treated at the hospital following the incident, her four charges were dismissed, and she was released from CCSO custody.
