Video released in Edisto Island ATM bombing

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Detectives from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division and Bomb Squad continue to follow leads regarding the Christmas Day attempt to breach an ATM using an explosive device at Enterprise Bank of South Carolina on Edisto Island.

Today, the Sheriff's Office released surveillance video showing a disguised person place a suspected pipe bomb at the door of a structure that houses the ATM before lighting a fuse. The device exploded and caused damage that allowed the subject to enter the structure, but the ATM itself was not breached, and no money was stolen.

The male subject was wearing a wig, hooded camo jacket, blue jeans and tan boots. Witnesses said the subject got into a dark-color hatchback, possibly an Audi, with a possible fishing rod sticker on the back window. The car was being driven by someone else, the witnesses said. The vehicle also was captured in the surveillance footage. Follow the link below to the full footage:
