Lincolville situation resolved peacefully

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – Deputies from the Charleston County Sheriff's Office peacefully resolved a situation Wednesday morning on Pickens Street in the Lincolville area.

About 3 a.m., dispatchers received a call in which a man threatened law enforcement.

Deputies responded to the area of Pickens and Jackson streets to conduct a welfare check. After establishing a perimeter around a home, the deputies made contact with a man inside. He ignored deputies' initial commands.

Before 7 a.m., a young adult male walked out before the man released a small child from the home. The man surrendered peacefully a short time later and was detained for further investigation.

There were no injuries. At this time, no charges have been filed. Detectives are continuing to investigate statements made in the phone call.
