North Charleston man faces multiple charges of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor

NORTH CHARLESTON, S.C. – The Charleston County Sheriff's Office arrested Kyle Spencer Miller, 27, of North Charleston, on Wednesday, October 30, 2024, on multiple charges related to crimes against children.

On October 14, 2024, officials with the South Carolina Department of Probation, Parole and Pardon Services were conducting routine house checks on registered offenders across the region. During the visit to Miller's home, child sexual abuse material was discovered. The Charleston County Sheriff's Office was immediately notified. Detectives then determined new charges were appropriate.

Miller is charged with five counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor in the Third Degree. Enclosed in this release are the affidavits with each charge.

Miller was given a \$250,000 bond during a hearing on Thursday, October 31, 2024.
